



#### **BRIGHT SMILES CHARITY RIDE**

Austinmer NSW to Bungendore NSW (via the Victorian High Country & the Snowy Mountains)

2<sup>nd</sup> to 6<sup>th</sup> May 2019

The Bright Smiles Charity Ride will be held over 4 evenings and 4 days, commencing with welcome drinks and dinner at 6:30 pm at the Headlands Hotel Austinmer Beach on Thursday evening 2<sup>nd</sup> May 2019.

Our overnight stops will be at Merimbula on Friday 3<sup>rd</sup> May, Omeo on Saturday 4<sup>th</sup> May and Jindabyne on Sunday 5<sup>th</sup> May. The event will conclude at lunchtime on Monday 6<sup>th</sup> May at Bungendore, just outside of Canberra. This will allow local participants time to be at home for dinner with their family on Monday evening.

Participation in the Bright Smiles Charity Ride is a reward for raising \$1,250 (or more) for the Royal Flying Doctor Service South Eastern Section Dental Program, and is an event for motorcycles that are registered to be ridden on the road in Australia. All participants must hold a full riding licence accepted in Australia.

Entries must be made using the following form, and will be processed on a first come, first served basis. All entries are subject to acceptance by the event organiser, and the event organiser reserves the right to refuse entry for any reason.

To register for the event participants are required to either post or email the form to the Bright Smiles office, together with your separate cheques (or credit card details) for both your Disbursements & Meal (D&M) money for each participant, as well as your Entry Fee for each motorcycle.

#### WHAT DOES IT COST?

**The Entry Fee** - \$165 per motorcycle. Payable to the Outback Car Trek Pty Ltd with your entry form.

**Disbursements & Meal Money** - \$480 per participant payable to the Outback Car Trek Pty Ltd with your entry form.

Both the Entry Fee & Disbursements & Meal Money include GST.

**Donations** – are all allocated to the RFDS S-E Section Dental Program and are payable to the Royal Flying Doctor Service S-E Section. All donations over \$2 are tax deductible.

Donations are not subject to GST.

The Bright Smiles Charity Ride has an umbrella account with the Everyday Hero fundraising website, and upon receipt of your entry form you will be issued with a unique funding web page to help you on your way. Please do not open your own web page, this will be done for you. You can then personalise your page with your own messages and photos if you wish.





The fees you pay are calculated on a cost recovery basis, and they are designed to ensure that nobody is out of pocket with the event. The Entry Fee (per vehicle) is designed to cover the costs associated with the creation of the event, setting the route, travelling the route to ensure its suitability, dealing with suppliers and stakeholders, web site costs, printing, public liability insurances and much more. The Disbursements (per person) covers all of your meals on the event, from the welcome dinner to the farewell lunch, volunteer's costs, and more. Both Entry & Disbursements fees include GST.

As previously stated all of your meals, from the welcome dinner to the farewell lunch are included in your disbursements fee. Your guests are welcome to join us at the Awards Dinner at Jindabyne on Sunday night (subject to space availability) for the food cost only of \$55.

You are responsible for your out of pocket expenses such as drinks and souvenirs and also your accommodation each evening.

On the next page you will find the names of some recommended accommodation providers, but remember - you are required to pay for your own bookings.

A motorcycle trailer will be provided to follow the field and assist any broken down bikes, by transporting them to the next available town (or back to Sydney if possible). A luggage vehicle will also be provided for your use, contact us and we will arrange to get from you your luggage in the week leading up to the event. Please make sure your piece of luggage is clearly marked with your personal details.

All donations are allocated by The Royal Flying Doctor Service South Eastern Section to support their Dental Program, and all donations are paid directly into an RFDS bank account. All donations are 100% tax deductible.

Web-based fund raising is becoming a very popular way for people to donate to charity, and the RFDS have a relationship with EveryDayHero. We will open an EveryDayHero web page for you to help with your fundraising if you wish – just let me know.

### THE 2019 BRIGHT SMILES CHARITY RIDE

#### The Accommodation:

Due to accommodation issues in a couple of the towns, I have block booked rooms for our group in Merimbula and Omeo, and I have negotiated prices for our group in Austinmer and Jindabyne (but I have not booked any rooms for you in Austinmer or Jindabyne).

(You are not required to stay at the motels I have booked/recommended, you are more than welcome to source your own accommodation if you wish.)

It is a little complex, but the details are:

Thursday 2<sup>nd</sup> May – Headlands Hotel Austinmer Beach - \$185 per room, either double or twin share. Drinks & dinner are here. To receive this rate, ring the hotel direct on 02 4200 1099 and you must mention "Bright Smiles Charity Ride". If you book over the web you will not receive the \$185 discount rate.

I have not booked any rooms for you at Austinmer, you will need to ring and book your own accommodation.

• Friday 3<sup>rd</sup> May – Sea Spray Motel Merimbula. Dinner will be in Market Street, a 600-metre walk from the Sea Spray. The main issue in Merimbula is that most motels demand a 2-night stay, and to complicate things there is a classic car rally based in Merimbula on the same weekend we are there. I have spoken to the Seaspray Motel and they will provide us with rooms for the one night only on Friday 3<sup>rd</sup> May - www.merimbulaseaspray.com.au. The rate is \$135 for either a double or twin share room, they also have deluxe suites available at \$155 per room.

I have block booked rooms for our group – if you want to stay at the Sea Spray let me know on the entry form or by email please. Do not contact the Sea Spray yourself.

- Saturday 4<sup>th</sup> May Omeo, the Golden Age Hotel. Dinner is here, and all rooms have an ensuite. The price per room is \$130 for either a double or twin share.
  - I have block booked rooms for our group if you want to stay at the Golden Age let me know on the entry form or by email please. Do not contact the Golden Age yourself.
- Sunday 5<sup>th</sup> May Jindabyne. Dinner and breakfast is at the Banjo Paterson Inn, right in the centre of town. <a href="www.banjopatersoninn.com.au">www.banjopatersoninn.com.au</a>. They have offered us the discount rate of \$120 per room for either a double or twin share room. To receive this rate, ring the hotel direct on 02 6456 2372 and you must mention "Bright Smiles Charity Ride". If you book over the web you will not receive the \$120 discount rate.

I have not booked any rooms for you at Jindabyne, you will need to ring book your own accommodation.





### THE 2019 BRIGHT SMILES CHARITY RIDE

#### The Route:

The fun will begin with drinks and the welcome dinner at the Headlands Austinmer Beach Hotel on **Thursday 2nd May 2019**. The hotel & region has a lot to offer and there is much to see and do before pre dinner drinks commence at 6:30 pm.

**Friday 3rd May - 385 kms, 4.5 hours** (est.) riding time. After a briefing this morning we get away from **Austinmer** after a hearty breakfast and head down the coast, dropping into Berry for morning tea, then lunch on the water at Batemans Bay. After a stretch and refuel we continue our southern journey via Moruya and Narooma to our resting place for the evening, **Merimbula**.

(Riders who would like to spend a little more time enjoying the countryside might like to turn off the highway near Tilba Tilba, and travel via Bermagui, Tathra and Tura Beach. This route is a similar distance, but expect to take an hour longer to reach Merimbula.)

**Saturday 4th May - 369 kms, 4 hours 20 minutes** (est.) riding time. This morning we head westwards to morning tea at Bombala, then south towards Cann River before we stop for lunch at Orbost where the Princes Highway crosses the Snowy River. After lunch at Orbost we head westwards through Nowa Nowa, the gateway to Lakes Entrance, then north to our resting spot for the evening, the picturesque town of **Omeo**.

((Those seeking a few more twists and turns on the road today can take the roads less travelled, via Bombala and Delegate before re-joining the group for lunch at Orbost. This is a further 40 kms (including 105 kms of winding road) and will take an extra hour.))

**Sunday 5th May - 380 kms, 5.5 hours** (est.) riding time. Today we take what is surely one of the most scenic rides in the **High Country**. We head northwards from Omeo up the incredibly beautiful Mitta Mitta Valley, through Eskdale and Tallangatta to our lunch stop at **Corryong**, the town that lays claim to being the home of "The Man From Snowy River". We soak up the atmosphere of this historic region over lunch, then it is back in the saddle as we continue to head northwards, moving from **High Country** to the ski fields of the **Snowy Mountains** via Khancoban and Geehi. We then skirt around Mt Kosciuszko and travel through Thredbo to our overnight stop of **Jindabyne**.

Tonight will be our presentation dinner, where we can all "frock up" for the evening.

**Monday 6th May - 196 kms, 2 hours 15 minutes** (est.) riding time. All good things must come to an end, and this morning we leave the Snowy Mountains in our rear vision mirrors as we head through Berridale, Cooma and Queanbeyan to the pretty little town of**Bungendore**, near Lake George, where we say our farewells over lunch ands plan the 2020 BSCR event.

(From Bungendore, our Sydney & Newcastle riders have several options to travel home. The route via Tarago and Goulburn is 250 kms to Parramatta and will take around 2 hours 40 minutes. People who still would like some adventure might consider riding home via Braidwood to Nowra, then through Nowra and the Kangaroo Valley to Bowral and then home. This option is 340 kms to Parramatta and will take around 4 hours 30 minutes.)





### BRIGHT SMILES CHARITY RIDE ENTRY FORM
