



2022 BRIGHT SMILES CHARITY RIDE

Thursday 28th April to Wednesday 4th May

2022 will see the Bright Smiles Charity Ride enter its seventh year raising funds for the Royal Flying Doctor Service South-Eastern Section Dental Program.

Thirsting for a decent adventure after the lockdowns caused by the Covid Pandemic, the 2022 Bright Smiles Charity Ride will be longer than previous years - a six night bitumen ride. Each days the ride can be split into several "sections", aimed at providing participants with the chance to stretch their legs every couple of hours (max).

To make things a little more comfortable for riders (and to enable you to frock up for dinner each evening), a luggage car is provided to enable you to take a suitcase without loading up your bike too much. There will also be a breakdown trailer following our group, just in case.....

Each day of the BSCR is designed to be ridden in 2 or 3 (or more) sections and is designed to fit in more with the mixed riding skills of our group. This enables the day to flow a little easier for the early birds, or those who decide to take a side trip and ride a few extra kms.

We won't all leave town together, so if you want to get up and get going early after only a cup of coffee you can, and you won't have to wait at lunch for those that decided on a more leisurely start to the day with a 3-course breakfast. The same goes for lunch - if you decide you want to just grab a snack and keep going - do that and everybody will catch up at the **HAPPY HOUR**.

Every night we will continue to host the **HAPPY HOUR** at the back of the luggage truck, and we will have our group dinner and daily awards at a nice restaurant or a quality pub every night. The dinner and happy hour are included in the disbursements fee, and you pay for breakfast and lunch yourself.





WHAT DOES IT COST?

The Entry Fee - \$175 per vehicle. Payable to the Outback Car Trek Pty Ltd.

Disbursements & Meal Money - \$535 per participant payable to the Outback Car Trek Pty Ltd. This fee covers your evening meal and your **HAPPY HOUR**. (If people are not able to attend all of the nights, let me know and I will amend the cost of the Disbursements Fee accordingly.)

Donations – participation in the Bright Smiles Charity Rides is a reward for raising \$1,250 (or more) for the Royal Flying Doctor Service S-E Section. All donations over \$2 are tax deductible.

For those who are able to raise more than the \$1,250 minimum donation, the Cuffe Family Foundation has offered to match the extra donation dollar for dollar – thank you Cuffe Family Foundation!!

Web based fundraising is a unique and easy way to help you raise funds. Please do not open your own web page, this has already been done by the RFDS and you can then personalise your page with your own messages and photos if you wish.

<u>Accommodation:</u> You will be required to pay for your own accommodation, and it is fair to say that this is one of the more vexing issues of any trip. Different people like different styles of accommodation and often as the event approaches availability in the towns we visit starts to dry up. This is especially so since COVID has hit.

As a precaution in each of our overnight towns I have pre-booked 15 "quite good" motel rooms for our group to use. If you want to take advantage of these rooms (at cost) book them through me and pay me when you enter the event. You are under no requirement to stay there - you may want to pitch a tent, or book your own rooms, or stay with a long-lost rich uncle, just let me know. The rooms I have reserved are on a first come basis and I will return any unused/unpaid for rooms 30 days prior to the event to the motel operator.
